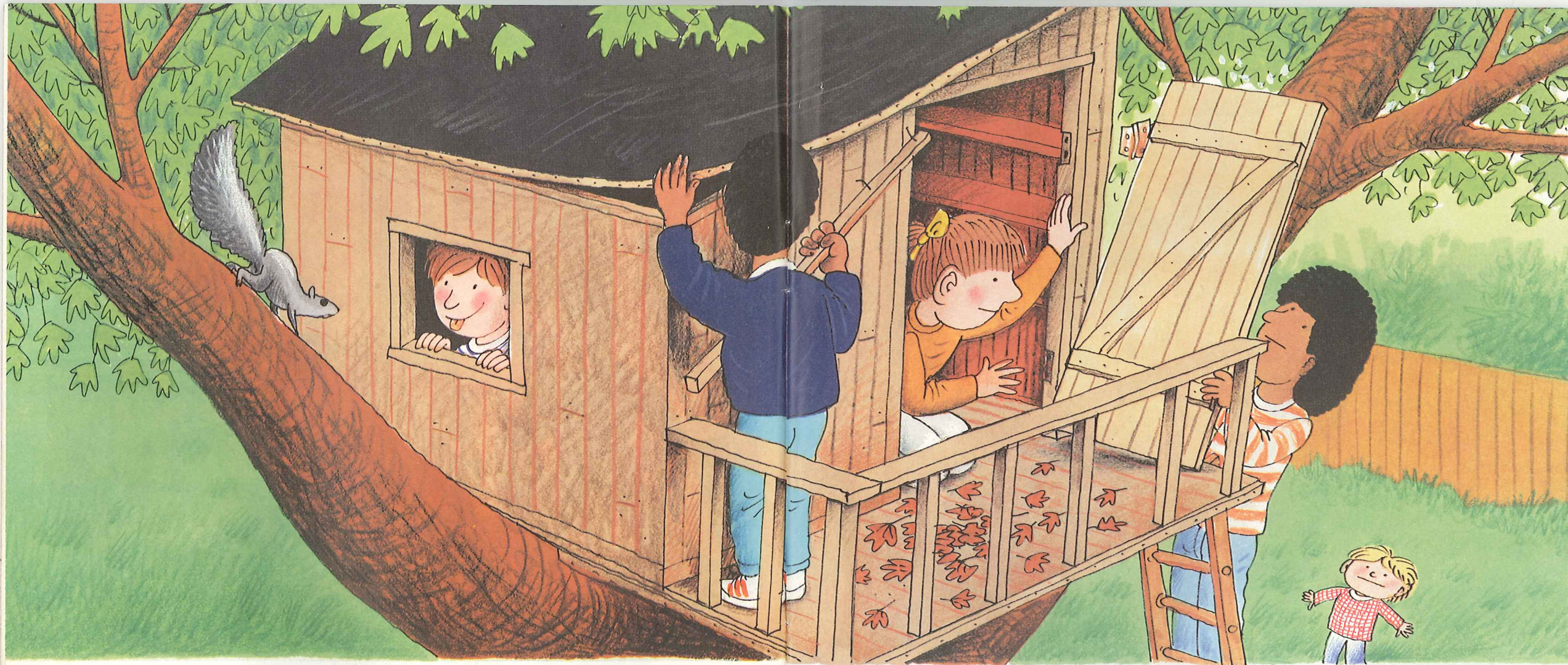

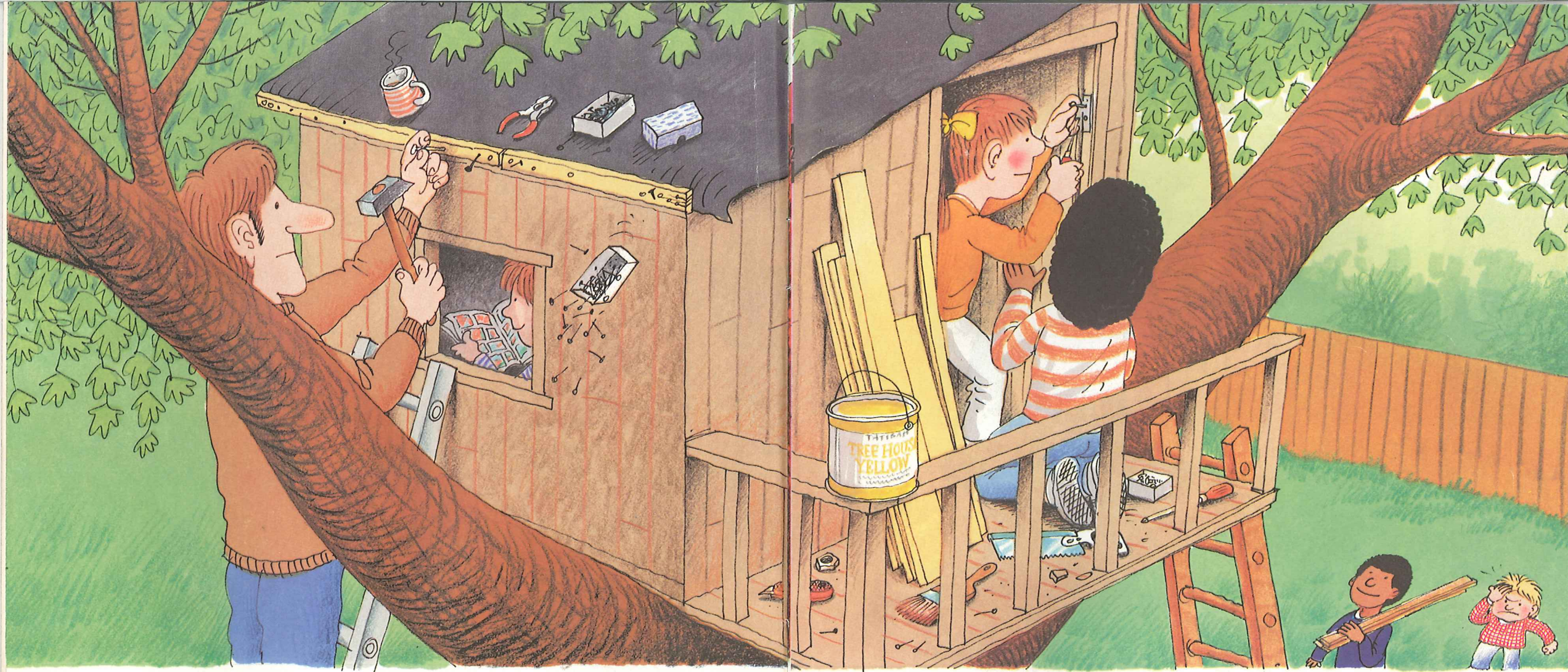


Wilf and Wilma came to the house.

‘What a storm!’ said Mum.



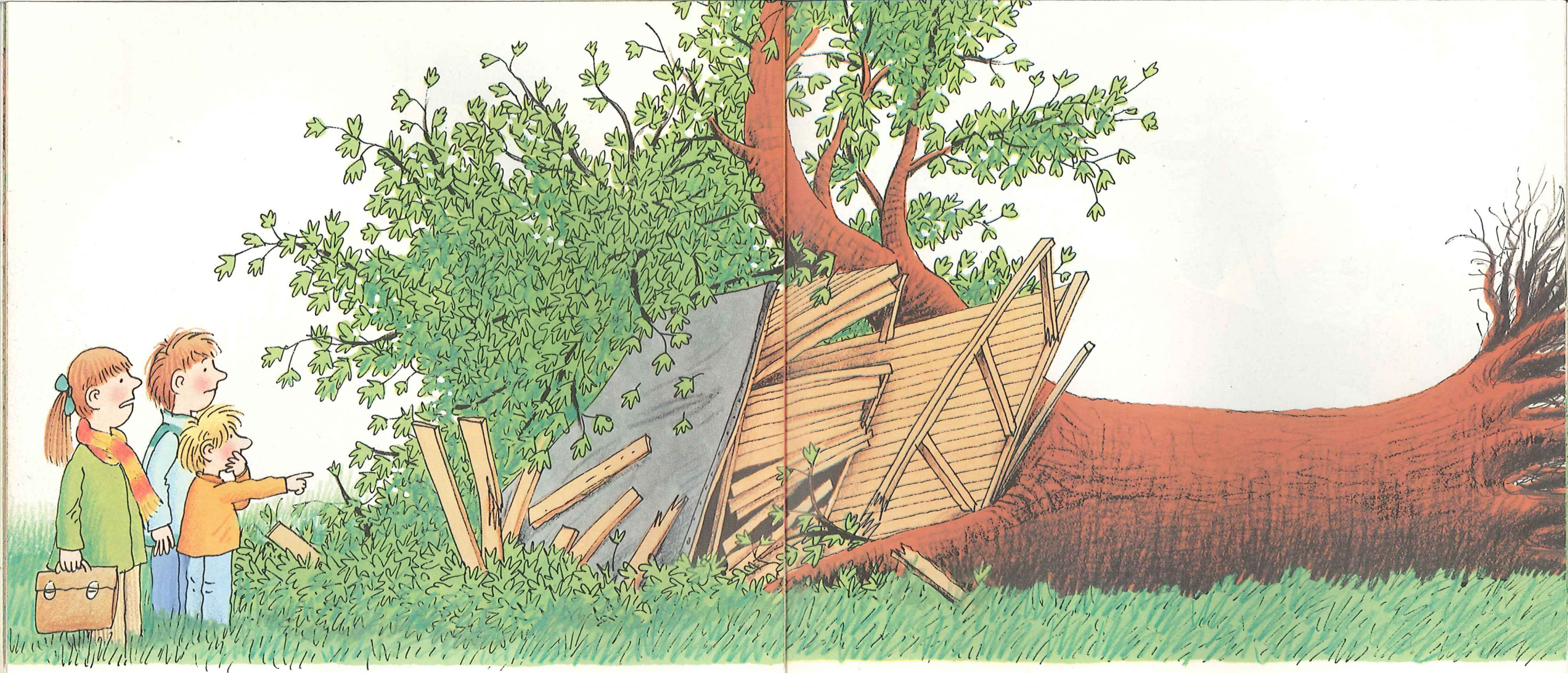
The wind blew.

Floppy barked and barked.

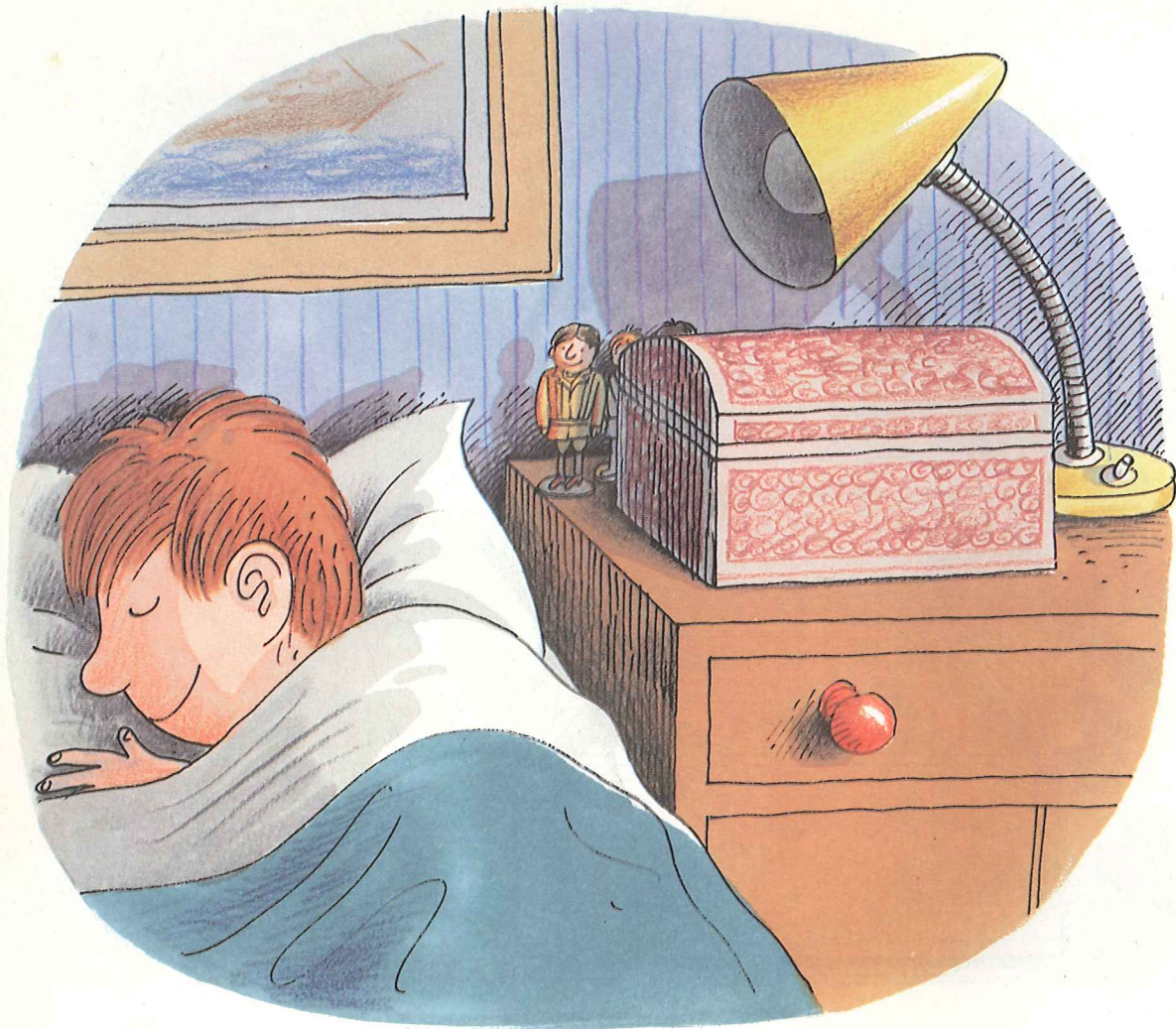


Floppy found something.
